Internship Program Admissions

The Health Service Psychology Internship Program at Wasatch Mental Health requires applicants to have met the following requirements for admission:

1. Advancement to candidacy;
2. Successful completion of comprehensive examinations or equivalent;
3. Dissertation proposal accepted;
4. A minimum of 400 direct contact intervention hours;
5. A minimum of 100 direct contact assessment hours;
6. Successful completion of at least three (3) years of graduate education or course work required by academic program;
7. Submission of a current resume or C.V.;
8. Submission of an official transcript(s);
9. Submission of three (3) letters of recommendation;
10. Completion of the APPIC Application for Psychology Internships (AAPI);
11. Complete necessary documentation for Background Criminal Investigation.
12. Intern attends a regionally accredited Counseling or Clinical Ph.D. or Psy. D. program.
